On July 5, 2005, State Route 92 in Susquehanna County was designated as the Viaduct Valley Way Scenic Byway. After further approval of Nicholson Borough, Nicholson Township, Lemon Township, Tunkhannock Township, and the Wyoming County Commissioners, the byway designation of Route 92 was extended into Wyoming County to bring the total length of the byway to 37.3 miles. Our scenic byway is a valuable resource recognized by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and provides opportunities for enhanced tourism and community and economic development.

We kindly ask for your support for the Viaduct Valley Way Scenic Byway. Our group – Friends of the Viaduct Valley Way Scenic Byway – is seeking financial and volunteer support from individuals, businesses, community groups, and municipalities having potential connections with the scenic byway.

The byway is good for the businesses and municipalities along PA Route 92 for many reasons including 1.) Vital to the Economic Stability of the Region, 2.) Brings Tourism to the Region, and 3.)
